



Caribbean Hardwood Pure FSC Parasol

Tradewinds Caribbean Hardwood Parasols are manufactured from high specification materials that are suitable for outdoor conditions. High quality materials and workmanship ensure that Caribbean Hardwood umbrellas are the no 1 choice for leisure, corporate and promotional use.

The Frame of Caribbean Hardwood umbrellas are made from the finest kiln dried Eucalyptus timber that is FSC (Forestry Stewardship Council) certified and assembled with stainless steel fittings for high durability. Fabric options are naturally resistant to rotting and mildew, acids and alkalis and in addition, all fabrics are Teflon treated to provide water, oil and soil protection.

- Frame produced from FSC certified Eucalyptus Grandis (saligna)
- Strut section 21 x 28mm
- All fittings and fasteners produced from marine grade stainless steel 304
- Stainless Steel Pulley system

The wood in Caribbean Hardwood frames come from well managed forests independently certified in accordance with the rules of the Forest Stewardship Council. Certified by SGS Qualifor, certificate no. SGS-COC-003833. Manufactured in South Africa by Tradewinds Parasol (Pty) Ltd.

Opening the umbrella and Safety

When opening the umbrella, pull out the ribs to ensure they move freely, then gently pull on the pulley cord to slowly raise the sliding hub upwards. Continue to raise until the fabric is taut and then insert the pin into the highest possible hole. A tautly erected Umbrella will be stronger and will not allow the canvas to whiplash in the wind which may cause the strut ends to break. The umbrella should be closed prior to the onset of strong gusty wind conditions and covered with heavy duty protective PVC cover only when dry.

Timber Maintenance

The timber components of this umbrella were treated with Natural Timber Sealer, a polymerized oil that penetrates the wood and deposits a waxy layer on the surface. It is recommended that Natural Timber Sealer or similar high quality sealer or penetrating oil specified for outdoor applications be used for maintenance of the wooden frame.

Fabric Maintenance

To clean the fabric, open the umbrella and put on its side and remove dirt using a soft brush with water. In order to protect the Teflon properties, use only a mild detergent that does not contain ammonia and never dry-clean the fabric.

Guarantee

Caribbean Hardwood umbrellas are guaranteed, from original date of purchase by the initial buyer, for a period of 2 years against defects in metal fixtures & fittings and against defects resulting from faulty workmanship. Although the manufacturer strives to provide the highest quality, we accept no responsibility for defects in timber, colour variation of processed wood, fading of fabric or fabric print degradation. The manufacturer will not be liable for any extra costs incurred by the buyer as a result of defects found in the product or as a result of faulty product, over and above those covered in the guarantee contained in the paragraph above.
